Data from the NIMH Data Archives were used in the Study, Brain Hyperconnectivity in Children with Autism and its Links to Social Deficits (published in [Cell Reports, Nov 2013](#)), and included Archived data. The NIMH data archives has a practice of archiving data when it has been updated (*i.e.*, replaced by more recent data) or when there were problems with the data (*e.g.*, data entry errors).

As a general rule archived data are no longer accessible, except where needed to support reproducibility of results. This study includes the same data accessed by the authors. Please consider that archived data may be either out-of-date or unreliable.

There are several measures mentioned in the publication associated with this study that are available from the NIMH Data Archive, but that are not included in this study package.
